

Art Year 3

Term 1

Neolithic cave Paintings

We will use paint, chalk and brown paper to make prehistoric style 'cave' paintings.

Vocabulary: symbols, , thickness, depict, emulate, convey, smudging, stippling, tone, shade, line.

Skills: You will use different brush techniques to produce shapes, textures, patterns and lines. You will learn to hold a brush in a flexible way.

You will predict the colours that you mix.

You will find out where each of the primary and secondary colours sits on the colour wheel



Term 3

Clay Greek Theatre Masks

We will be sculpting expressive ceramic masks in an Ancient Greek style.

Vocabulary: form, expression, impression, sculpting, application, slip.

Skills: You will create shapes that look like different facial expressions.

You will use tools to create varied textures for hair, skin, teeth, eyes, beard.

You will sculpt smooth curves and patterns.



Term 5

Stencil street art/graffiti We will be using stencils and sponged paint to make fun, colourful wall art.

Vocabulary: stencil, graffiti, wall art, stippling, high contrast, monochrome.

Skills: you will use sponges in a controlled way to fill in texture on a stencil and use scissors to carefully cut out the stencil.

You will learn about negative space, and how stencils mask off areas to create form and shape.
