### Term 1

#### Isle of Lewis inspired Chess Pieces

We will be using air-dry clay to make our own ceramic chess pieces.

**Vocabulary:** blending, smoothing, applying, mark making, texture, indenting, caricature

**Skills:**

You will use smaller, more intricate tools to create a range of patterns and textures in clay.

You will explore proportion and 'caricature'.

You will manipulate the clay in a specific style.



### Term 3

**David Hockney iPad landscapes** We will be using iPads to create colourful landscape images.

**Vocabulary:** layering, depth, tone, shade, perspective, texture

**Skills:** You will explore the tools, nibs and brushes used in a Paint app and combine colours, tones and tints to enhance the mood of a piece. You will experiment with ways to create texture and reflection digitally.



### Term 5

#### Chalk/pastel Planetary drawings inspired by Luke Jerram

We will be creating images of planets in space, using pastels to make them look round and three-dimensional.

**Vocabulary:** 2D, 3D, tone, blending, spherical, light source, shadow, highlight

**Skills:** We will use a variety of techniques to add interesting effects.

We will use a range of media to add gradual blending of colour and tones.

We will use light and shade and blending to create realistic 3D shapes.
