Vocabulary

bend		Grab both ends and bring them together to make a curve.
squash		Push both hands together or squeeze something to make it flat.
stretch		Pull the ends apart to make something longer.
twist		Hold both ends and turn your hands in different directions.
elastic		Something that can be stretched or squashed and then springs back to its real shape all by itself, like a rubber band.
